Quiltricks

Stimulating imaginations of quilt tricksters everywhere

Quiltrick #71: When quilting by machine it's important to first take one stitch then pull the top thread so the bobbin thread comes completely through to the front in the hole of the stitch you just made. That way the thread will not make a "bird nest" on the back of your fabric and you can knot it together with the top thread and bury it in your quilt later. No one will ever know where you started quilting! Do the same with your last stitch when you finish quilting.
