



Oops! Baby *burp* cloth

This is a great "go-to" pattern for a quick baby shower gift. It's soft, absorbent and baby and mommy will both love it!

Supplies: ½ yard each of flannel and minky (or any other soft absorbent cotton) Matching thread, scissors, sewing machine, some 8-1/2" x 11" paper and a pencil. You should be able to make four **Oops!** cloths from this amount of fabric.

Directions:

1. Prewash your fabrics!
2. Cut two paper patterns on the lines all the way to the bottom of the page. Tape both patterns together at the straight edge and you will have your full pattern.
3. Place flannel and minky right sides together and pin paper pattern on top. Cut along outside edge.
4. Remove paper pattern, and pin fabrics together. (minky has a tendency to shift)
5. Sew around all edges with a ¼ inch seam leaving a 2-3 inch opening for turning. Trim seam to 1/8 inch.
6. Turn fabrics to the outside and press well.
7. Slip stitch opening closed
8. Top stitch ¼ inch from all outside edges
9. Quilt by stitching straight lines from top to bottom every inch or so. Or something fancy!
10. Repeat and you'll have two lovely **Oops!** Cloths to gift to your favorite mom-to-be.
